



Myanmar Excursion 14 – 19 MAR 2010

Sunday 14 March Bangkok – Yangon

0600 meet ACT representative at Suvarnabhumi Airport, Gate 4, TG counter

0800 Depart by TG 303

0845 Arrive Yangon Airport. Transfer to Park Royal Hotel or similar. Sight seeing in Yangon: Visit Chaukhtakyi, a colossal Reclining Buddha; Sule Pagoda, a beautiful octagonal golden stupa in the heart of Yangon.



Lunch at Monsoon restaurant. Drive along Pansodan Street where you can find the colonial buildings and the famous Strand hotel built more than 100 years. In the late afternoon, proceed to Shwedagon Pagoda and enjoy the very special atmosphere at sunset.

Dinner at Karaweik Hall with Myanmar dances.

Overnight at Park Royal Hotel.

Monday 15 March Yangon – Bagan

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for flight to Bagan.

Arrive at Nyaung Oo Airport and check in at the hotel. Pagoda, the prototype of later Myannar stupas; Wetkyi-in Gubyaukkyi Temple, with fine mural paintings of Jataka scenes; Htilominlo Temple, noted for its plaster carvings; the City Gate, the oldest extent of Bagan architecture.

Lunch at Sunset Garden restaurant.

Afternoon tour include Gawdawpalin Temple, panoramic view of Bagan; Ananda Temple, an architectural masterpiece resembling a Greek Cross; Sulamani Temple, a typical Myanmar temple with two high storeys; Damayangyi, a massive temple with the finest brickwork and sunset at Guni temple.

Dinner at Nanda restaurant with puppet show.

Overnight at Aureum Palace Resorts.

Tuesday 16 march Bagan – Mandalay



Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for flight to Mandalay. Arrive at Mandalay airport and transfer to the hotel for check in. Sightseeing tour to famous Mahamuni Pagoda; gold leaf hammering; Shwe Inbin Monastery, an excellent specimen of Myanmar wooden architecture ; silk weaving cottage industry. **Lunch** at Ko's Kitchen.



Afternoon tour of Mandalay including Shwenandaw Monastery, noted for its exquisite wood carvings; Kuthodaw Pagoda, known as the World's Biggest book for its stone slabs of Buddhist scriptures; Kyauktawgyi Pagoda a large Buddha image carved out of a single block of marble; and enjoy sunset at Mandalay Hill, a vantage point for panoramic view of the City. Dinner at Mandalay Hill Resorts.

Wednesday 17 March Mandalay – Inle lake

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the airport for flight to Heho. Drive to Nyaungshwe, then take a boat to Khaungdine and check in at Pristine Lotus Spa resorts. An excursion to Inle Lake famous for its unique leg-rowers and scenic beauty. Tour highlights Phaungdaw Oo Pagoda; wonderful floating gardens; and see the natives method of fishing.

Lunch at Golden Kite restaurant. Cotinuous tour to weaving village of Inpawkhon and village life on the lake; Ngaphekyang monastery, collection of Buddha statues dating back to 150 years.

Dinner at the hotel.

Overnight at Pristine Lotus Spa Resorts.

Tuesday 18 March Inle – Yangon

Drive to Taunggyi, 1430 above sea level, where you can stroll around the market and lunch at Ayethayar vineyard. After lunch transfer to Heho airport for flight to Yangon.

Dinner at Park Royal Hotel.

Friday 19 March Yangon

Breakfast at the hotel. Drive to Bago, 80 km northeast of Yangon where you will visit Shwemawdaw pagoda, higher than the Great shwedagon pagoda; Shwethalyaung reclining Buddha image once lost and overgrown by jungle.

Lunch at Shwe Pyi restaurant.

Afternoon shopping at Bogyoke market (Scott Market).
